It was a pleasure to meet with you regarding your current proposed activity. Thank you to all who attended.

C-Tec Solar, LLC is proposing the development and operation of a 2.011 MW AC solar generating facility to be located at the closed Bristol Landfill and active Transfer Station at 685 Lake Avenue in Bristol. The parcel currently consists of a capped landfill with a vegetative cover layer. There is a wetland corridor southwest of the project area. The Bristol Landfill is located in a Natural Diversity Area.

The extent of land area proposed to be utilized for this project is 7.72 acres for the installation of 2 solar array areas that will be surrounded by protective fencing. The eastern solar array area is planned to be located on top of the landfill and the western solar array area is planned to be located behind the existing transfer station. An existing gravel road is located just north of the proposed western solar array area which provides access to the top of the landfill (proposed eastern solar array area).

The applicant intends to utilize this existing access road to keep disturbance to a minimum. The ground-mounted solar arrays are proposed to be supported by ballasted concrete blocks designed to maintain the integrity of the landfill final closure system.

Based upon the information presented at the meeting, a summary of the permitting requirements is as follows:

Stormwater Program: your contact is Chris Stone

A Stormwater Construction General Permit (GP) will not be required for this project if disturbance is less than an acre. Please refer to the newly revised Stormwater Manual, Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control, and stormwater guidance for solar projects in the construction stormwater general permit (Appendix I) to address specific details and questions that you might have concerning your project.

Note that the newly revised Stormwater Manual was published on October 1, 2023, which includes an increase in the Water Quality Volume storm from 1" to 1.3". If at least 50% of your project design was completed prior to publication, and construction will be completed within one year of publication, the previous manual may be used. If this is the case, please notify the Stormwater Program before proceeding.

Additional Notes:

- A diversion swale is not needed but a gravel swale is recommended to spread the water.
- Use low impact equipment to install solar array system for minimal disturbance.

Waste Engineering & Enforcement Division: your contacts are Frank Gagliardo & David McKeegan. There are two requirements outlined below needed for a landfill such as Bristol that is both a solid waste landfill and a hazardous waste landfill:

1. All landfills (MMCA/WEED): A submission of a Disruption of a Solid Waste Disposal Area Authorization permit application is required. Information that will be required to be provided with the application includes detailed site plans, construction plans, geotechnical investigation data, and lease agreements. There is no fee for the application, which has an average review time of approximately three to six months. Please refer to the Guidance for Disruption Activities, Closure Activities, and/or Post-Closure Use at Solid Waste Disposal Areas for additional information.

In addition, a written request to change the landfill's post-closure use will be needed and must be attached to the above permit application submittal package. A change in the Post-Closure Plan is a straightforward task for both the solid waste and hazardous waste permits, which are combined in the Stewardship Permit for the Bristol Landfill, numbered DEEP/REM/SP/2023-10588- See Attached.

DEEP's Solar Permitting Factsheet explains the disruption authorization/change in post-closure use approval request process. This is a quick process but it is important for planning for the construction, operations, and decommissioning phases.

2. RCRA Hazardous Waste Landfills (WPLR/Remediation): The landfill permittee, operator, and owner simply requests a Class 1 or 2 modification of the landfill's Post-Closure Permit ("Stewardship Permit"). The permittee must notify the Commissioner of the change in the Post-Closure Plan to determine the type of permit modification to be processed. Class 1 is for minor changes in the permit, including changes in equipment, monitoring, and maintenance. Class 2 is for changes in the Post-Closure Plan necessitated by events at the facility. Check with the Remediation Division on their preference. The difference basically relates to the level of community engagement, so the Public Participation Plan for the property may inform the decision. For example, public notice of the modification to certain local and state government representatives and to persons on the facility mailing list is required within 90 days of the change in the Post-Closure Plan. A public comment period and public meeting is required for a Class 2 modification.

Additional Notes:

- Signage is needed to be posted on the fence that will surround the solar arrays.
- Be sure equipment is low pressure for minimal disturbance.
- When installing the poles near the transfer station, if waste from the landfill is encountered, that waste needs to be shipped off site.

Environmental Review Program: your contacts are Fred Riese & Linda Brunza

Since the proposed project size is above 1 MW, one must apply to the Connecticut Siting Council. For most solar facility projects, application to the Siting Council can be made as a Petition for Declaratory Ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required. Applicants to the Siting Council are encouraged to visit the Connecticut Siting Council website.

Remediation Program: your contact is Carl Gruszczak.

At this time there is no soil reuse planned. If there ends up being a need to reuse soil, then the applicant should reach out to the Remediation Division.



Additional Notes:

• The City of Bristol applied for a CT DEEP Stewardship Permit, and it was approved in March 2023 (effective for 10-years). As discussed above, the addition of solar to the landfill will require updating the Post-Closure Plan, which would also require a modification of the Stewardship Permit (most likely a Class 1 with Pre-Approval). The process to modify the Stewardship Permit is to submit an Application (there is a location to indicate that it is a modification request), but it is recommended to reach out beforehand to discuss what is actually needed and not needed in the modification application.

Land & Water Resources Division: your contact is Susan Jacobson.

At this time there are no permits needed.

National Diversity Database (NDDB): your contact is Robin Blume

A Natural Diversity Database review request was submitted on December 11, 2023, and a Final Determination letter was issued on December 20, 2023 (Filing ID 104610). Please follow the guidance provided, and you may use this Determination to demonstrate compliance with CT's Endangered and Threatened Species Act. If you have any questions, please contact your reviewing biologist or Robin Blum for further information.

Environmental Justice Program: your contact is Edith Pastana.




