Re: **PETITION NO. 1646** – Kinsley Energy Systems, LLC (Kinsley Group, Inc.) petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 300-kilowatt AC battery energy storage facility and associated equipment to be located at the New Canaan YMCA, 564 South Avenue, New Canaan, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection. **Notice of Satisfaction of Conditions.**

Dear Executive Director Bachman:

By its undersigned counsel, Petitioner in the above-titled proceeding hereby notifies the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) that it has satisfied the conditions set forth in the Council’s February 21, 2025, Final Decision.

Condition 3 requires Petitioner to “*provide a copy of the final Emergency Response Plan (ERP) that includes an itemized list of fire suppression equipment to local emergency responders prior to facility operation, and provide emergency response training.*” Please see the final ERP that Petitioner provided to local emergency responders included in the zip file accompanying this letter.

Condition 4 requires Petitioner to “*provide a signed certification by the Fire Chief that training has been completed and the ERP is approved prior to commencement of operation.*” Please see certification included in the zip file accompanying this letter, signed by the Fire Chief certifying approval of the ERP and that training for local emergency responders has been completed.

Condition 5 requires Petitioner to “*submit a copy of the building permit prior to commencement of operation.*” Please see the building permit from the Town of New Canaan included in the zip file accompanying this letter.

Condition 7 requires Petitioner to “*submit a post-construction operational noise study that documents compliance with state standards and the identification of any noise mitigation measures that*

*are employed to adhere to the standards, if necessary.*" Please see the operational noise study report with appendices included in the zip file accompanying this letter.

Condition 11 requires Petitioner to notify the Council within 45 days after completion of construction and to provide a representative photograph of facility. Petitioner hereby notifies the Council that construction was completed approximately 45 days ago. Please see photographs of the facility included in the zip file accompanying this letter.

The Council acknowledged that Petitioner satisfied condition 6 on March 10, 2025. Therefore, Petitioner has satisfied all relevant conditions of the Council's February 21, 2025, Final Decision.
