RE: **PETITION NO. 1655** – Borrelli Solar LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 1.99-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility and associated equipment to be located at 179 and 197 Borrelli Road, East Haven, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection. **Incomplete Notice.**

Dear Attorney Melone:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received the petition for the above-referenced facility on January 7, 2025.

According to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-39a, “No declaratory ruling shall be issued to any person until a complete petition containing all information deemed relevant by the Council has been filed.”

Pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-40, “Prior to submitting a petition for a declaratory ruling to the Council, the petitioner shall, where applicable, provide notice to each person other than the petitioner appearing as record as an owner of property which abuts the proposed primary or alternative sites of the proposed facility, each person appearing of record as an owner of the property or properties on which the primary or alternative proposed facility is to be located, and the *appropriate municipal officials and government agencies*. Proof of such notice shall be submitted with the petition for declaratory ruling.” (Emphasis added.)

The term “appropriate municipal officials and government agencies” refers to the officials and agencies to be noticed under Section 16-50l of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended October 1, 2024 by Public Act No. 24-144. The Office of Consumer Counsel was not notified. Additionally, the Towns of North Branford and North Haven are located within 2,500 feet of the proposed site and were not notified.

Therefore, the petition is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Borrelli Solar LLC provide proof of service of a copy of the petition on the Office of Consumer Counsel and the Towns of North Branford and North Haven, on or before February 7, 2025. If additional time is needed to provide the required information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to February 7, 2025.
