**Re: Petition 1674 – Greenskies Clean Energy, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 1.99-megawatt solar photovoltaic electric generating facility and associated equipment located on seven parcels (Parcel Nos. 1304-1740-16 through 1304-1740-24 and 1304-1240-118) on Soundview Drive and Newton Road, Woodbridge, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection**

Dear Ms. Bachman:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Greenskies Clean Energy LLC (“Greenskies” or the “Petitioner”), in connection with the above-referenced Petition. On December 11, 2025, the Connecticut Siting Council (the “Council”) issued a declaratory ruling approving the Petition, subject to a variety of conditions. The Petitioner respectfully requests that Council staff review the submittals enclosed with this letter and approve its pre-construction conditions as described herein.

Pursuant to Condition #6, in **Exhibit A**, the Petitioner provides final project site plans. The final site layout uses 530 and 540-watt modules, which reduces the overall project size to 1.75MW AC. Greenskies has also increased the interrow spacing in the solar array. Because of the changes to the overall system size, the interconnection route was adjusted as was proposed in the Petition. The final layout provides reduced visibility from neighbors and property lines. Conditions #4 (box turtle protection plan) and #5 (natural fiber erosion control measures) are described on sheet C110 in Exhibit A.


Pursuant to Condition #3, in **Exhibit B**, the Petitioner hereby provides the final structural design for the racking system stamped by a Connecticut Professional Engineer. In compliance with Condition #8, the Petitioner hereby confirms that construction work hours will not begin before 7:00 AM. Pursuant to Condition #3, the Petitioner provides its final Spill Prevention Plan in **Exhibit C**. Finally, pursuant to Condition # 7, in **Exhibit D**, Greenskies has provided a final Visual Mitigation Plan.

In conformance with Council regulations, the Petitioner hereby notifies the Council that it intends to commence pre-construction site mobilization activities on or about April 27, 2026. Greenskies has submitted its Stormwater General Permit Application to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (“DEEP”), and understands there is a significant backlog due to recently implemented software changes at DEEP. The Petitioner will not commence land disturbance activities until it receives its Stormwater Permit and submits the same to the Council pursuant to Condition #2. However, the Petitioner is seeking approval from the Council to commence activities that do not involve land disturbance prior to its receipt of the Stormwater Permit.
