2. **DOCKET NO. 307A** – SBA Infrastructure LLC Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 71 Pleasant View Road, Derby, Connecticut. Connecticut Siting Council Motion to Reopen this Certificate to eliminate Condition No. 3 of the December 19, 2024 Modified Decision and Order based on changed conditions pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b).
