

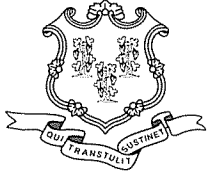

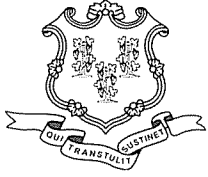
Council Interrogatories

1. Provide the size and characterize the quality of the wetlands that are within the substation parcel.
2. How many acres is the parcel on which the substation will be located? How many acres will be permanently disturbed for the location of the substation?
3. Provide an aerial photograph of the proposed substation property, with the wetlands within the parcel marked, at a scale of 1 inch = 100 feet.
4. Has CL&P tested soils at the substation parcel for trichloroethylene (TCE) as recommended by the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection in the Docket 272 record? If not, would this be completed prior to construction?
5. Has CL&P received a coastal permit from the Office of Long Island Sound Programs as ordered in the Council's Decision and Order # 18b?
