From I-95 northbound:

Take exit 13 (Boston Post Road/Route 1)

Take first right onto Richards Avenue to Flax Hill Road

Turn left onto Flax Hill Road and proceed to Highland Avenue (triangle on right)

Turn right onto Highland Avenue

From I-95 southbound:

Take exit 14 (Route 1)

Turn left at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 1

Turn left at the first traffic light onto Scribner Avenue

At the end of Scribner Avenue, turn right onto Flax Hill Road


Turn left onto Highland Avenue (it is the second street on the left off of Scribner Ave.)
