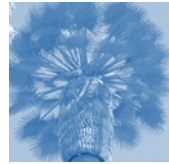


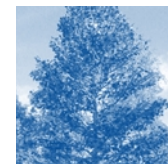

Leslie Cauley, Telecommunications Writer, USA TODAY



The Symposium's keynote speaker is Leslie Cauley, a telecommunications writer with USA TODAY. Ms. Cauley has been a business journalist for more than twenty years,

spending nine years as a staff writer and editor for *The Wall Street Journal*. Ms. Cauley has been nominated for the Pulitzer Prize three times and is the author of *End of the Line: The Rise and Fall of AT&T* (Free Press, August 2005).

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council), formerly known as the Power Facility Evaluation Council, was established in 1971 to balance the need for adequate and reliable public services at the lowest reasonable cost to consumers while protecting the environment and the ecology of Connecticut. In addition to various forms of energy facilities, the Council's jurisdiction extends to specific forms of telecommunications infrastructure including:

- Cable television towers and head-end structures, including associated equipment.
- Telecommunications (cellular and PCS systems) towers owned or operated by the state, a public service company, intrastate telecommunications service providers, or used in a cellular system.

The Council is part of the executive branch of the State of Connecticut and derives its operating revenues from application fees and assessments charged to the applicants. The Council meets most often to review energy and telecommunications matters, typically every two to four weeks.
