**COMMENTS OF CONGREGATION B'NAI JACOB,
EZRA ACADEMY, THE JEWISH FEDERATION OF GREATER NEW HAVEN
AND THE JEWISH COMMUNITY CENTER OF GREATER NEW HAVEN
ON THE SITING COUNCIL'S DRAFT SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS OF FACT
DATED SEPTEMBER 21, 2006**

Congregation B'nai Jacob, Ezra Academy, The Jewish Community Center of Greater New Haven, and The Jewish Federation of Greater New Haven have the following comments on, and suggested corrections to, the Siting Council's Draft Supplemental Findings of Fact, dated September 21, 2006. The number of the paragraph below corresponds to the number of the proposed findings of fact being commented on.

SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES

24. In the second sentence, delete "The proposed modification" and insert in lieu thereof "Under the route approved in the Council's D&O,". (Reason: the measurements contained in this sentence all refer to the Council's approved route and not to any changes in the route which would result from the proposed deviation.) Add at the end of the paragraph the following sentence. "The proposed relocated ROW would move the ROW 40 feet farther to the north, resulting in the closest 345-kV conductor being 300 feet from the building. B'Nai Jacob, Ezra Academy, JCC, JFNH 1, pg. 4-5. Tr. 1, p. 92." (Reason: this accurately reflects that the proposed deviation would move

the right of way 40 feet farther from the building resulting in the closest 345-kV conductor being 300 feet from the building as opposed to the 260 feet under the Council's April 7, 2005 D&O.)

CLARIFICATIONS and CORRECTIONS

4. A typographical error in paragraph 4 should be corrected by deleting "0" immediately after "UI," in the first line.

13. In the second sentence after "As part of the," insert "proposed," and insert a comma after "court settlement". In the third sentence, after "ball field" insert "nature trails and other outdoor activities associated with the JCC Camp (other than the in ground pool)". (Reason: to clarify that at the current time there is only a "proposed" court settlement.)

14. In the third sentence after "as a result of a," insert "proposed". (Reason: to indicate that the settlement is simply proposed at the present time.)

17. In the fourth sentence after "ROW to the east", insert "on the CL&P property". (Reason: to clarify the statement.)

18. In the second sentence, delete "approximately" and insert "more than". (Reason: to accurately reflect the cited testimony as well as the actual facts.) In the third sentence delete "approximately" and insert in lieu thereof "more than". (Reason: same as change in previous sentence.) In citation at the end of the paragraph, after "78," insert "96" and delete "67" and insert in lieu thereof "71". (Reason: to accurately reflect the pages on which the cited testimony is found.)

19. In the first sentence, before "re-routed ROW" insert "proposed". (Reason: to make it clear that this refers to the proposed deviation being considered by the Siting Council at the current time and not the re-routing of the right of way contained in the Council's April 5, 2005 D&O.)


22. At the beginning of the paragraph insert "In the proposed relocated transmission lines," and in the first sentence after "angle," delete "in the proposed transmission lines". (Reason: to clarify the sentence.) Delete the last sentence of the paragraph which currently states "The angle structures would be taller." (Reason: no factual support for such statement in the record.)

23. In the second sentence delete "proposed relocated" and insert "Council approved". (Reason: the clearing referenced is not caused by the proposed deviation, but was part of the relocation of the right of way ordered by the Council in its April 7, 2005 D&O.)

41. Beginning in the middle of the fourth line, delete "with further definition by the Council take into consideration residential areas, private or public schools, licensed child day care facilities, licensed youth camps, or public playgrounds, adjacent to the proposed route of overhead portions". (Reason: Redundant or duplicative language.)

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
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
