

Enclosed are the Council's Supplemental Findings of Fact, Opinion and Decision and Order.

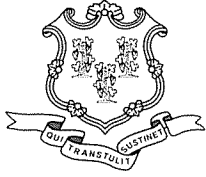

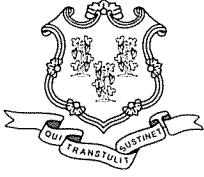

Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50p (d), the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) announces that, on October 10, 2006, the Council issued Supplemental Findings of Fact, Opinion and Decision and Order approving the proposed modifications to the Woodbridge portion of the Segment 2b through the Development and Management Plan in regards to The Connecticut Light and Power Company and The United Illuminating Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction of a new 345-kV electric transmission line and associated facilities between the Scovill Rock Switching Station in Middletown and the Norwalk Substation in Norwalk, Connecticut. On October 31, 2006, the Council issued Supplemental Findings of Fact, and Opinion approving the correction to the Supplemental Findings of Fact and Opinion issued on October 10, 2006.
