## I. <u>DEFINITION</u>

As used in these interrogatories, the term "Structure" includes any home or other residential building (whether single or multiple unit), any building containing a business or businesses, any private or public school, any licensed child day care facility, any licensed youth camp, and any public park, playground or other public recreational facility.

# II. INTERROGATORIES

1. Reference Volume 1 of the Application dated October 9, 2003. For the Applicants' preferred overhead route, identify each Structure in the Town of Durham, any portion of which is within the existing right-of-way.

2. Reference Volume 1 of the Application dated October 9, 2003. For the Applicants' preferred overhead route, identify each Structure in the Town of Wallingford, any portion of which is within the existing right-of-way.
