The Towns of Durham and Wallingford (collectively hereinafter the
"Towns"), hereby request that The Connecticut Light & Power Company ("CL&P")

and The United Illuminating Company (“UI”) answer the following interrogatories.¹

The Towns request that the Applicants provide responses to the interrogatories on or before June 30, 2004; however, the Towns encourage the Applicants to submit responses to individual interrogatories as such responses become available. In the event that any interrogatory requests specific data or information that has already been provided in this proceeding, the Respondent need only specifically identify where the responsive data or information is located in the record.

If there are objections to the interrogatories or if providing responses to individual interrogatories would be unduly burdensome, the Towns request that the Applicants contact the undersigned as soon as possible.

I. DEFINITION

As used in these interrogatories, the term “Structure” includes any home or other residential building (whether single or multiple unit), any building containing a business or businesses, any private or public school, any licensed child day care facility, any licensed youth camp, and any public park, playground or other public recreational facility.

II. INTERROGATORIES

1. Reference Volume 1 of the Application dated October 9, 2003. For the Applicants’ preferred overhead route, identify each Structure in the Town of Durham, any portion of which is within the existing right-of-way.
2. Reference Volume 1 of the Application dated October 9, 2003. For the Applicants’ preferred overhead route, identify each Structure in the Town of Wallingford, any portion of which is within the existing right-of-way.
