Before each group of evidentiary hearings, parties and intervenors are encouraged to file pre-hearing interrogatories and exchange pre-filed testimony, exhibits, witness lists, and items to be noticed administratively with all other parties and intervenors. To save the time and expense of parties, intervenors, and the public, all parties and intervenors are encouraged to resolve discrepancies of these items before the hearing.
 - 3. All parties and intervenors shall resolve discrepancies regarding appearances of witnesses. The order of appearances must be presented to the Council no later than the determined pre-file date.
 - 4. The Council requests filings be in electronic PDF format on floppy disc, compact disc, or via email.
 - 5. The Council is requesting that all filings be submitted on recyclable paper, primarily regular weight white office paper, consistent State Solid Waste Management Plan. Please avoid using heavy stock paper, colored paper, and metal or plastic binders and separators.
 - 6. Parties and intervenors with the same interest are encouraged to form groups for the purpose of cross examination and presentation of witnesses and exhibits. These groupings shall notify the Council and all other parties and intevenors no later than the determined pre-file date.
 - 7. Individuals will be encouraged to participate through their elected officials and other party or intervenor groupings.
 - 8. All participants will be encouraged to be brief, concise, non-repetitious, and courteous of all other participants. *No repetition of facts will be allowed*. (Emphasis added)

From I-84 East (Waterbury)

Exit 35 (left exit) onto Route 72 East. Take third exit, marked Main Street. At the end of the exit take a right and travel one block to Chestnut Street. Turn right onto Chestnut Street and travel one block to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

From I-84 West (Hartford)
