### Minutes of March 3, 2011.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the Minutes of March 3, 2011, seconded by Mr. Wilensky. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. F-2010 - Connecticut Siting Council Review of the Ten-Year Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources. Draft Report.

No action was taken on this item.

DOCKET NT-2010 - Reopening of final decisions pursuant to C.G.S. §4-181a(b) for jurisdictional natural gas-fired electric generating facilities under C.G.S. §16-50i(a)(3) and C.G.S. §16-50k(a) limited to Council consideration of changed conditions and the attachment of conditions to the certificates and declaratory rulings consistent with the findings and recommendations in the Final Report issued by the Kleen Energy Plant Investigation Review Panel (Nevas Commission) and the findings and recommendations in the Executive Report issued by the Thomas Commission. Draft Findings of Fact.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the Draft Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Caruso requested a written vote on the record with Chairman Caruso, Mr. Lynch, Dr. Bell, Mr. Murphy, Mr. Ashton, Mr. Tait, Mr. Wilensky, and Mr. Levesque, in favor of attaching conditions to the Certificates consistent with the Thomas and Nevas Commission Recommendations.

DOCKET NO. 272 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company and The United Illuminating Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction of a new 345-kV electric transmission line and associated facilities between the Scovill Rock Switching Station in Middletown and the Norwalk Substation in Norwalk, Connecticut. Partial Transfer of Rights and Obligations.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the Partial Transfer of Rights and Obligations from CL&P to CTMEEC, seconded by Mr. Wilensky. The motion passed with Dr. Bell abstaining.

DOCKET 370A-MR –The Connecticut Light & Power Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Manchester Substation to Meekville Junction Circuit Separation Project in Manchester, Connecticut. Designation of Independent Environmental Inspector.

Mr. Tait moved to approve the BSC Group as the Independent Environmental Inspector for the project, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed with Mr. Lynch abstaining.

DOCKET NO. 385 – Florida Tower Partners Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and management of a telecommunications facility located at 23 Stonybrook Road, Stratford, Connecticut. Development and Management Plan.
