PETITION NO. 983 - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 4.8 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located on Flagg Hill Road, Colebrook, Connecticut. Draft Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

Mr. Ashton moved to grant FairwindCT's Motion to Strike the Draft Interim Raptor Report filed by BNE, seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Wilensky arrived at 11:15 a.m.

Dr. Bell moved to approve the Findings of Fact, as amended, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Wilensky moved to approve the Opinion, as amended, seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed with Mr. Ashton voting no.

Dr. Bell moved to approve the Decision and Order, as amended, seconded by Mr. Wilensky. The motion passed with Mr. Ashton voting no.

Mr. Murphy moved to approve the Conclusions of Law, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 984 - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 4.8 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located on Winsted-Norfolk Road (Route 44), Colebrook, Connecticut. Draft Findings of Fact.

Mr. Ashton moved to grant FairwindCT's Motion to Strike the Draft Interim Raptor Report filed by BNE, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ashton moved to deny FairwindCT's Motion to Strike BNE's Post Hearing Brief, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Levesque arrived at 2:50 p.m.

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After reviewing the Draft Findings of Fact, Chairman Stein conducted a non-binding straw poll of the Council members with Mr. Murphy, Dr. Bell, Mr. Wilensky, Mr. Golembiewski, Mr. Levesque, and Chairman Stein, in favor of the proposed facility, and Mr. Ashton voting no.

Chairman Stein directed staff to draft a favorable Opinion and Decision and Order to be reviewed at the next meeting.
