# Minutes of September 22, 2011.

Dr. Bell moved to approve the minutes of September 22, 2011, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed with Chairman Stein abstaining.

LIFE-CYCLE 2011 – Connecticut Siting Council Investigation into the Electric Transmission Line Life-Cycle Costs. Request for Party/Intervenor Status.

Mr. Lynch moved to approve party status for the Office of Consumer Counsel, seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. 354 - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and management of a telecommunications facility located off of Old Baird Road, Watertown, Connecticut. Extension Request.

Mr. Wilensky moved to approve Cellco's request for an extension of the deadline to complete construction of the approved facility until November 8, 2012, seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. 417 - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at Moose Hill Road, Guilford, Connecticut. Draft Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

Mr. Murphy moved to approve the Draft Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order, seconded by Mr. Tait. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1006 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to an existing guyed lattice tower located at 181 Garden Hill Circle, Waterbury, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Wilensky moved to approve the petition, seconded by Mr. Lynch. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1007 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications of existing double circuit 345-kV transmission lines in Waterford, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Golembiewski moved to approve the petition, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.
