Minutes of November 17, 2011.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the Minutes of November 17, 2011, seconded by Mr. Murphy. No vote was taken.

Mr. Murphy moved to table the Minutes of November 17, 2011, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

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DOCKET NO. 400 - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 343 Daleville Road, Willington, Connecticut. Request for Extension.

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Mr. Tait moved to grant an extension for construction of the facility until February 2, 2013, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. 410 - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 234 Melba Street, Milford, Connecticut. Transfer of Certificate.

Mr. Wilensky moved to approve the Transfer of Certificate to Construction Services Towers, LLC, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed with Dr. Bell abstaining.

DOCKET NO. 423 - North Atlantic Towers, LLC, and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located off of Route 198, Woodstock, Connecticut. Completeness Review, Schedule, Custodian of the Docket, Deposition of the Transcript, Request for Party/Intervenor Status.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the application as complete, approve the schedule for processing the docket as per staff recommendations, the appointment of Carriann Mulcahy as custodian of the docket, the deposition of the transcript in the Town of Woodstock, and a public field review and hearing in Woodstock on Tuesday, January 10, 2012; seconded by Mr. Tait. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 501A - New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the approval upgrade in Petition No. 501 for the existing Connecticut Light and Power Company electric transmission facility located at 27 Cannon Road, Wilton, Connecticut. Decision.

Dr. Bell moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 984 - BNE Energy, Inc. declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 4.8 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located on Winsted-Norfolk Road (Route 44), Colebrook, Connecticut. Development and Management Plan.

This item was passed temporarily.

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PETITION NO. 1009 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed installation of a 85-foot steel pole and associated radio communications equipment located at Rapids Road, Stamford, Connecticut. Decision.

No action was taken on this item.

PETITION NO. 1012 - MetroPCS Massachusetts, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications of an existing telecommunications facility located at 75 Wells Road, Wethersfield, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Levesque moved to approve this petition with the condition that MetroPCS install one additional planting on the south side of the compound, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1013 - United Illuminating Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed 8300 Line reconfiguration in New Haven, Connecticut. Decision.

Dr. Bell moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

CSC Fiscal Year 2013 Budget.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the Budget for FY 2013, seconded by Mr. Wilensky. The motion passed unanimously.
