TS-CL&P-151-121206 – The Connecticut Light and Power Company and Yankee Gas Services Company Request for an Order to Approve the Shared Use of an Existing Telecommunications Facility located at 207 Garden Hill Circle, Waterbury, Connecticut.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve this tower share request with the following conditions:

- The proposed coax lines shall be installed in accordance with the recommendations • made in the Structural Analysis Report prepared by FDH Engineering dated October 17, 2012 and stamped by Christopher Murphy; and
- Not more than 45 days following completion of the antenna installation, CL&P shall • provide documentation certified by a professional engineer that its installation complied with the engineer's recommendation.

Emergency Disaster Recovery Deployment - EM-CING-085-121218 - notice of intent to install a temporary cellular telephone facility for use at town own property located at 375 Fan Hill Road, Monroe, Connecticut. Request to Waive Application Fee. Decision.
