Minutes of December 27, 2012.

Siting Analyst Supervisor

Mr. Murphy moved to approve the minutes of December 27, 2012, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. 432 – Feasibility study of back-up power requirements for telecommunications towers and antennas pursuant to Public Act 12-148. Draft Study.

The Council reviewed the draft study and directed staff to make changes to be reviewed at the next meeting.

PETITION NO. 1044 – MetroPCS Massachusetts, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a wireless telecommunications facility on an existing Connecticut Light and Power Company transmission structure located at 250 Olcott Street, Manchester, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Lynch moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Wilensky. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1045 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a-250 kW Fuel Cell to be located at Sam's Club, 3465 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Caron moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1046 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 500 kW Fuel Cell to be located at Walmart, 155 Waterford Parkway North, Waterford, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Murphy moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Ashton. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1048 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 250 kW Fuel Cell to be located at Sam's Club, 69 Pavilions Drive, Manchester, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Tait. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1049 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 250 kW Fuel Cell to be located at Walmart, 495 Flatbush Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1051 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 400

kW Fuel Cell to be located at Walmart, 315 Foxon Boulevard, New Haven, Connecticut. Decision.

Dr. Bell moved to approve this petition with the condition that the petitioner shall submit a letter stamped by a P.E. duly licensed in the State of Connecticut to certify that the noise levels comply with the State of Connecticut noise control regulations, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1052 – BE 2012 W LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 200 kW Fuel Cell to be located at Walmart, 3164 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Caron moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Tait. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1053 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the removal of an existing 30-foot wood pole and replace it with a new 84-foot steel monopole and associated radio communications equipment located at 163 Lakeview Avenue, New Canaan, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Tait moved to table this item, seconded by Mr. Caron. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1054 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed installation of an 84-foot steel pole and associated radio communications equipment located at CL&P's substation on Prospect Street, Ridgefield, Connecticut. Decision.

Dr. Bell moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.
