Mr. Murphy moved to approve the minutes of January 10, 2013, seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed unanimously.

DOCKET NO. 429 - New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at one of two sites: Willington Tax Assessor Parcel ID #M23-P62 Tolland Turnpike, Willington, Connecticut; or Willington Tax Assessor Parcel ID #M18-19 Old South Willington Road, Willington, Connecticut. Draft Findings of Fact.

Caron, Mr. Ashton, and Chairman Stein in favor of issuing a certificate for the proposed Candidate Site A facility located at Willington Tax Assessor Parcel ID #M23-P62 Tolland Turnpike, Willington, Connecticut, and Mr. Hannon abstaining.

Chairman Stein directed staff to draft a favorable Opinion and Decision and Order to be reviewed at the next meeting.

DOCKET NO. 432 – Feasibility study of back-up power requirements for telecommunications towers and antennas pursuant to Public Act 12-148. Draft Study.

This item was temporarily passed.

DOCKET NO. 370 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Connecticut portion of the Greater Springfield Reliability Project that traverses the municipalities of Bloomfield, East Granby and Suffield, Connecticut. Request for Approval of Partial Transfer of Rights and Obligations.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the partial transfer of rights and obligations from CL&P to UI, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed with Mr. Lynch abstaining.

PETITION NO. 1047 – BE 2012 A LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 600 kW Fuel Cell facility to be located at 751 Higgins Road, Cheshire, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Caron. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1050 – BE 2012 A LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the installation of a 700 kW Fuel Cell facility to be located at 522 Fairfield Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut. Decision.

Dr. Bell moved to approve this petition with the condition that the petitioner submit a letter stamped by a P.E. duly licensed in the State of Connecticut to certify that noise levels comply with the State of Connecticut noise control regulations, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1053 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the removal of an existing 30-foot wood pole and replace it with a new 84-foot steel monopole and associated radio communications equipment located at 163 Lakeview Avenue, New Canaan, Connecticut. Decision.

PETITION NO. 1055 - New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed installation of telecommunications facility at an existing 300-foot guyed tower located at 855 University Drive (UCONN), Torrington, Connecticut. Decision.

Mr. Hannon moved to approve this petition, seconded by Mr. Caron. The motion passed unanimously.

PETITION NO. 1056 - GRE 314 East Lyme, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction and operation of a 5.0 MW Solar Photovoltaic Renewable Energy Generating Project located on Grassy Hill Road and Walnut Hill Road, East Lyme, Connecticut. Schedule.

Mr. Ashton moved to approve the schedule per staff recommendations, the appointment of Carriann Mulcahy as custodian of the petition, the deposition of the transcript in the Towns of East Lyme and Montville, a public field review and hearing in East Lyme on March 14, 2013; seconded by Dr. Bell. The motion passed unanimously.

Emergency Disaster Recovery Deployment - EM-CING-085-121218 - notice of intent to install a temporary cellular telephone facility for use at town own property located at 375 Fan Hill Road, Monroe, Connecticut. Request for Extension.

Mr. Caron moved to approve a 30-day extension for this temporary facility, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion passed unanimously.
