Development and Management Plan Revision.

Mr. Ashton moved to table this item pending receipt of additional information, seconded by

Mr. Murphy. The motion passed with Mr. Lynch abstaining.

PETITION NO. 1056 - GRE 314 East Lyme, LLC declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction and operation of a 5.0 MW Solar Photovoltaic Renewable Energy Generating Project located on Grassy Hill Road and Walnut Hill Road, East Lyme, Connecticut. Development and Management Plan Revisions.

Dr. Bell moved to remove this item from the table, seconded by Dr. Klemens. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Bell moved to approve the revision to the Development & Management Plan, seconded by Mr. Hannon. Dr. Bell withdrew her motion. Mr. Murphy moved to approve the revisions to the Development and Management Plan with the condition that the proposed driveway be used to access the electrical equipment only in the event of an emergency and for routine maintenance, seconded by Mr. Caron. The motion passed unanimously.

TS-AT&T-076-131023 - AT&T request for an order to approve tower sharing at an existing telecommunications facility located at 15 Orchard Park Road, Madison, Connecticut. Request to Revise.

Dr. Bell moved to approve the request to revise this tower sharing request, seconded by Mr. Caron. The motion passed unanimously.

CSC WIND REGULATIONS - Adoption of Regulations pursuant to Public Act 11-245, An Act Requiring the Adoption of Regulations for the Siting of Wind Projects, Sections 16-50j-2a, 16-50j-18 and 16-50j-92 to 16-50j-96, inclusive, of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
