Mr. Lynch moved to approve the Minutes of March 16, 2023; seconded by Mr. Silvestri. The motion passed unanimously.

Completeness Review, Schedule, Deposition of the Transcript.

Mr. Lynch moved to approve the schedule per staff recommendations; seconded by Mr.

Golembiewski. The motion passed unanimously.

4. PETITION NO. 1555 - Earthlight Technologies petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 1.9-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at Collins Aerospace, 1 Hamilton Road, Windsor Locks, Connecticut and associated electrical interconnection. Decision.

Mr. Silvestri moved to approve this petition with the conditions noted in the staff report and the additional condition that the final DEEP-approved Sand Barren Conservation and Mitigation Plan be submitted to the Council; seconded by Mr. Golembiewski. The motion passed unanimously.

5. PETITION NO. 1558 - Community Power Group LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 4-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 24 Middle Road, Ellington, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection. Schedule.

Mr. Silvestri moved to approve the schedule per staff recommendations; seconded by Mr. Lynch. The motion passed unanimously.

6. PETITION NO. 1559 - Crown Castle petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed replacement and extension of an existing telecommunications facility located at 41 Padanaram Road, Danbury, Connecticut. CGS §4-176 Deadline for Action – Set Date for Decision.

Mr. Nguyen moved to set the date by which to render a decision in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes § 4-176(e) and Section 16-50j-40(c) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as no later than August 1, 2023; seconded by Mr. Golembiewski. The motion passed unanimously.
