## Purpose:

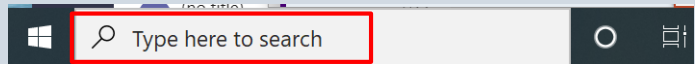
This job aid will help you take a screenshot on your Windows 10 computer

## Steps

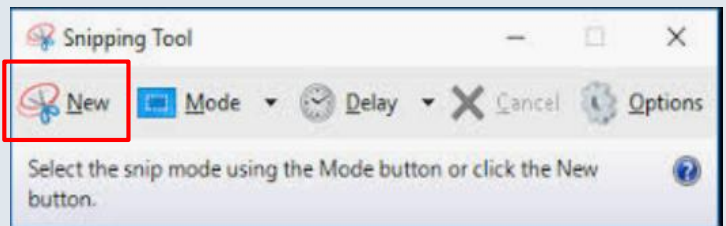
## Screenshots

To take a screenshot on your Windows computer, type "Snipping Tool" into your **Search bar**, in the bottom left hand corner of your screen.

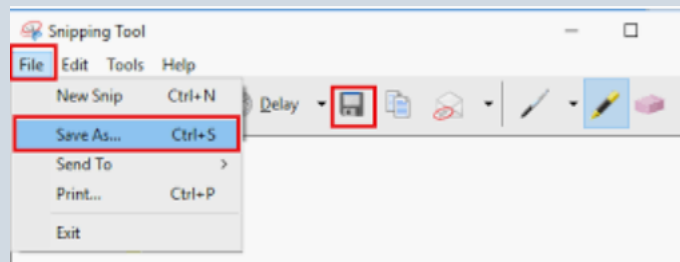
This is an image of the icon you should see.



Once you open the Snipping Tool application you can take a screenshot by pressing **New**. Once that is open your screen will be highlighted and your mouse turns into a cross. Click once to start the screenshot at one corner of what you want to capture, and drag to the opposite corner of the area to create a rectangle.



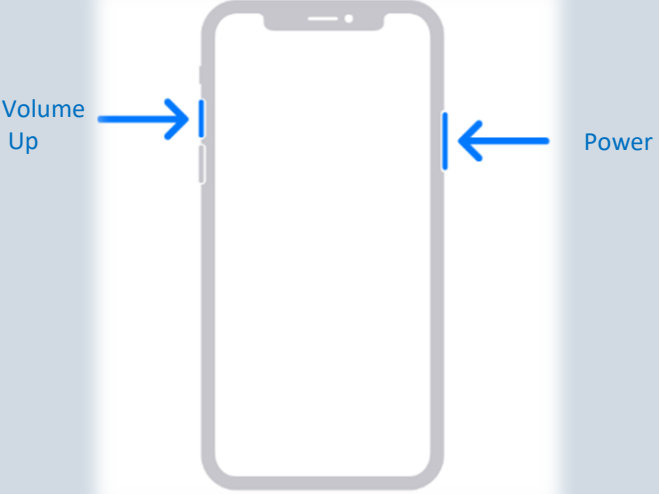
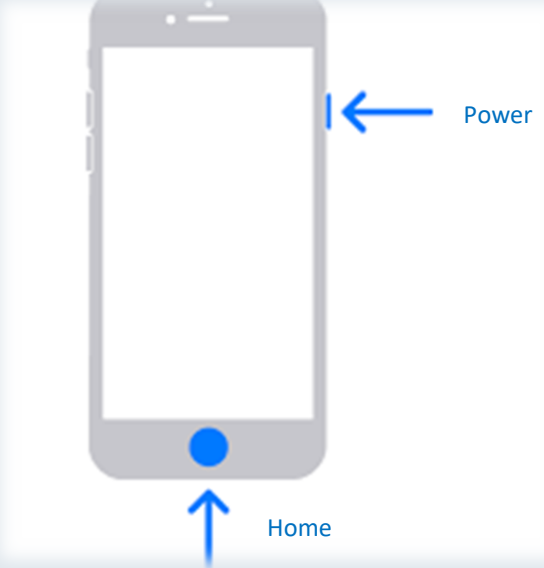
The screenshot will pop up and you can save it to your computer by pressing **File**, and then **Save As**.
