- **CEN Staffing**
 - CEN currently has 9 full time staff members, 5 part time student workers.
 - Lead Technical Engineer Rick Cheung started September 1, announcement attached.
 - Position Search Marking/Publicity reviews complete, waiting on approval to interview.
- Budget
 - Received ½ of the expected state appropriation for FY18; \$0 for FY19
 - Working on 5-year budget forecast looking at costs, consumption, growth, rate/price adjustments, etc.
- Value Added Services / Revenue Generation 4 modalities:
 - Monetize Existing
 - Expand Direct Services
 - Brokered Services
 - Contract Vehicle
- **CEN Outreach Events**
 - Oct 12 CIO/CXO Roundtable Yale University, Research Focused Topics
 - o Re-scheduling IP Address Management, DNS, DHCP w/ InfoBlox
- Threat Management / DDoS Mitigation
 - The automation of attack notifications moves to production this month. Notifications will be sent to affected members on the initiation and completion of each attack to provide awareness and detailed analysis of each event.
 - o Sept 6: largest attack yet K-12 member, IP Fragmentation attack. 1.7 million PPS, 20 Gbs Flow, for 25 minutes. Successfully mitigated by CEN team.
- NYC Buildout
 - NEREN Collaboration (RI, MA, VT, NH, ME, NY).
 - Benefits: increased ISP & Peering options. Peering reduces costs by reducing commodity internet growth rate.
 - Updated target completion date may be Spring 18; project delays with service provider have set back the project.
- **Library Connections**
 - This project leverages CT State Library bond dollars and federal E-rate funds.
 - o 56 libraries participating. 3 phased project across 2 years.
 - Phase 1: 23 Libraries, 12 online now, 9 scheduling for install of equipment, 2 fiber builds in progress
 - Phase 2: 22 Libraries, 3 scheduling for install of equipment, 19 fiber builds in progress
 - Phase 3: 10 Libraries, 9 applied for E-rate, 5 currently approved, PO to Lightower expected in early October, Project completion expected in May/June 2018
