

Proposed Endorsement of ISTE Standards for Education Leaders

The Commission endorses the International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE) Standards for Education Leaders. Released in June 2018, this new standard set results from the input of K – 12 school administrators and researchers to reflect best practices in leading with technology. These leader standards directly support both the Educator and Student Standards previously endorsed by the Commission.

The Commission remains committed to defining and supporting the competencies and skills that students and educators need for effective digital learning. This endorsement also aligns with the Commission's five-year Goals and Plan to refresh and support the application of technology standards for students, educators, and administrators. As part of this work, the Commission is actively working with organizations across the state to help ensure the application of these standards into teaching, learning, and leading in schools.
