Staff reported that DAS is requesting SPRB approval pursuant to CGS §4b-29 for the assignment of consultants under the Department of Children and Families ("DCF") LINK Program to 101 East River Drive. It is envisioned that these consultants will utilize approximately 9,397-SF of space within the building. This space is currently leased by the State of Connecticut and is under the custody and control of DAS for it BEST Division. BEST has recently been relocated to 55 Farmington Avenue and as such the lease area is currently vacant until termination of the lease on October 31, 2015.

DAS has agreed to provide this space to DCF at no charge except that DCF will be responsible for its own internet, phone and additional building services not included in the underlying lease. The MOU also includes an agreement that DCF must vacate the space by October 31, 2015 or the agency will assume responsibility of the monthly lease payment.

The MOU has been signed by DAS and DCF and includes the required approval by OPM.

Staff reported that this is the 7^{th} series of On-Call Architect Consulting Service Contracts awarded by the Department of Construction Services ("DCS") since 2002. The six On-Call Contracts that are the subject of this memorandum have a maximum total cumulative fee of \$1,000,000 per contract and a common expiration date of 01/15/2017.

A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the consultant services was released in June 2014 and elicited twenty-eight (28) responses. Three of the respondents were considered "unresponsive" and as such twenty-five submittals were considered for review. Thereafter, the DCS selection panel began the process of evaluating all 25 proposals. The State Selection Panel consisted of 5 members and rated each firm based upon a weighted ranking system. Upon completion of the internal review process the selection committee selected the top six firms for approval under this on-call series. During the course of the final selection and review, the Selection Committee opted to remove Tecton Architects, P.C. due to the fact that the firm currently has four active formal contracts underway which are being funded by the Department of Administrative Services. The Selection Committee approved the replacement of Tecton Architects, P.C. with Christopher Williams Architects, LLC.

Staff recommended Board approval of the following six (6) firms as on-call architecture consultants for projects of various sizes and scope. All six consultants provided the required insurance, Gift/Campaign and Consulting Affidavits accompanied by appropriate Corporate Resolutions. The six firms recommended for approval are:
