The purpose of this DOT project is to convert a portion of Burnside Avenue from four lanes to a two-lane road, creating bicycle lanes, bus stops and shoulders wide enough for parking in order to enhance the safety of pedestrians and cyclists on the section of U.S. Route 44 (Burnside Avenue) from Main Street, Route 5 to Mary Street, a distance of 2.76 miles.

The subject property is 0.96 acres (41,818 SF) of vacant commercial land. The parcel is fairly level and rectangular in shape with frontage on Burnside Avenue and Walnut Street. The site is in the B-2 Business zone, and the site was previously occupied with a gas station that was removed in 2011.

The taking area is 1,092 SF and impacts the northwesterly corner of the property at its intersection with Walnut Street, and extends along the Burnside Avenue frontage. The purpose of the taking is to allow enough space for a public bus stop and concrete pad along Burnside Avenue. Sidewalk and bike lane improvements are planned.

The raw data range indicated a site value between \$7.59/SF and \$14.06/SF. The DOT appraiser relied on the sale of the subject property. In 2011, ExxonMobil sold the site to Alliance Energy for \$500,000 (\$11.96/SF). In the appraiser's opinion, there is a \$13,000 loss in site value attributed to the taking.

Staff recommended approval of the item. The acquisition complies with Section 13a-73(c) of the CGS which governs the acquisition of property by the commissioner of transportation required for highway purposes. The damages are supported by the appraisal report prepared by DOT dated 8/25/14.

This is the 6th series of On-Call Multi-Disciplinary Engineering Consulting Service Contracts awarded by the Department of Construction Services ("DCS") since 2004. The six (6) On-Call Contracts that are the subject of this memorandum have a maximum total cumulative fee of \$500,000 per contract and a common expiration date of 02/28/2017.

A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the consultant services was released in June 2014 and elicited fifteen (15) responses of which all of the firms were considered to be responsive to the RFP. Thereafter, the DCS selection panel began the process of evaluating all 15 proposals. The State Selection Panel consisted of 5 members and rated each firm based upon a weighted ranking system.

Upon completion of the internal review process the selection committee selected the top six firms as well as the highest ranking MBE firm ("DTC") for approval under this on-call series. As such this series will include the submission of seven consulting firms. At this time DCS has submitted all of the firms except Langan CT, Inc. for review and approval by the Board

Staff recommended Board approval of the following six (6) firms as on-call multi-discipline engineering consultants for projects of various sizes and scope. All six consultants provided the required insurance, Gift/Campaign and Consulting Affidavits accompanied by appropriate Corporate Resolutions. The six firms recommended for approval are:
