The Department of Administrative Services ("DAS") is requesting SPRB approval pursuant to CGS 4b-29 for the Department of Rehabilitation Services ("DORs") to operate a cafeteria and store each comprising approximately 8,447-GSF and 336-GSF respectively. Each of these operations will be located within the new state office space at 450 Columbus Boulevard.

The MOU between DAS and DORs will allow the ongoing renovation project at 450 Columbus Boulevard to fund up to \$250,000 of infrastructure improvement within the demised premises. DORs will

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also agree to allocate \$250,000 of agency operating funds for the purchase of cafeteria equipment and furniture. DORs will also agree to repay the \$250,000 of infrastructure improvements in \$50,000/year

annual payments for 5 years.

DAS has concurred with agreement to provide this space to DORs at no charge and DORs has accepted the requirements, policies and procedures to utilize the space. The MOU may be terminated by either

agency with 180 days' notice.

Staff recommended approval of the item.
