

PROPOSED REVISIONS TO E-MOU

Appendix I: Onboarding New Agencies

- Proposed revisions would streamline the process to onboard new agencies.
- The new language was drafted based on discussion at the Executive Board meeting.
- Other revisions streamline the sections for voluntary separation from P20 WIN and reinstatement.

Appendix 2: Procedures for Breach Notification

- Proposed revisions add clarifying language and references the general statutes requirement to notice the Office of the Attorney General.
- This proposal came from the work done to create a P20 WIN Incident Response Plan







SFTP CONFIGURATION UPDATE

DGB Duties and responsibilities:

- Establish data governance policies to enable, improve and sustain the Data Sharing process and the Data Sharing Requests from the point of application through completion
- Develop policies and procedures, including but not limited to policies and procedures to ensure data privacy, confidentiality and security
- Receive reports of a Breach or a suspected Breach

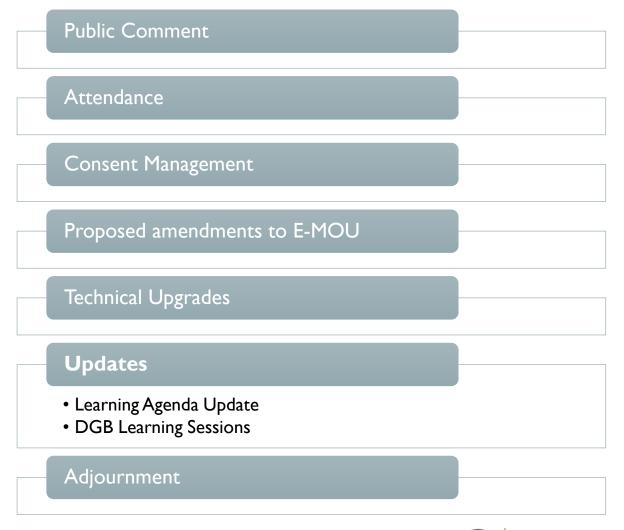
Why now?:

- Privacy and security of data are paramount
- Risk of breach for data in transit
- Increased reliance on SFTP applications as data requests and data usage accelerate
- Need to support audit, incident response and potential staff changes
