



















INCIDENT RESPONSE PLAN

1. Timeline for incident response plan:

- 1. Development of Incident Response Plan included in recommendations from Technical Upgrade Planning Group (July 2021)
- 2. Presented to Executive Board and Data Governing Board (August 2021)
- 3. Working Group established (BITS, CCEH, CSCU, DCF, DOL, OPM)
- 4. Discussed with Data Governing Board (September, November, December 2021), with Data Stewards, Working Group, support from BITS Security Team throughout

2. Final draft today for approval

- 1. Plan is done, but work is not! Will need to update and revise periodically
- 2. Provide options for training and learning to participating agency staff



SFTP CONFIGURATION

Why now?

- Privacy and security of data are paramount
- Risk of breach for data in transit
- Increased reliance on SFTP applications as data requests and data usage accelerate
- Need to support audit, incident response and potential staff changes


DGB Duties and responsibilities:

- Establish data governance policies to enable, improve and sustain the Data Sharing process and the Data Sharing Requests from the point of application through completion
- Develop policies and procedures, including but not limited to policies and procedures to ensure data privacy, confidentiality and security
- Receive reports of a Breach or a suspected Breach

How SFTP used now

- Participating agencies send data to DOL
- Participating agencies send data to Data Recipient
- DOL sends data to Data Recipient
- Occasional sharing of Resultant Data between agencies for analysis



 HMIS/DOL quarterly data match (#35) will help CCEH understand which programs a client may be eligible for based on income




