1. Discount prescription drug card

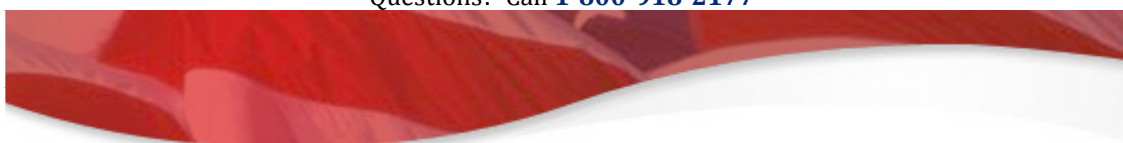
Uses:
