TIPS FOR TABLET DEPLOYMENT

- Below please find the steps that will be followed when the tablets are distributed at Central
 Office. You must be mindful of the following: If you are not feeling well, self isolating or
 quarantined DO NOT come to pick up your tablet. Other arrangements will be made to give you
 the device. Secondly, you are responsible for picking up your own tablet. NO ONE else can pick it
 up for you.
- We have marked space in the downstairs lobby that complies with social distancing. When people
 arrive, they can stand in those areas or they may stand outside and we will call them in when we
 are ready.
- When called, you are guided to the stairs. There will be three people on the stairs spaced out appropriately. When called to the top stair, you will be asked to sign in. Please bring a pen with you. If you do not have one, one will be given to you but you will be asked to disinfect it using a wipe when you are done.

- Once you sign in, you will go to one of the tables. One of the trainers, and or an IT person will give you the tablet, case and handout. You will be asked to sign a form indicating you received the tablet.
- Once done at the table, you will be asked to go to the 6th floor. An Academy staff member will greet you and send you and send you to a classroom.
- We have 4 rooms available. Each room will hold no more than 5 people including the trainer. The tables have been arranged so that they comply with the social distance requirements.
- While in the room you will be given instructions on how to log in, and hook to the network. This will hopefully ensure that you are connected successfully at home. When you are done you may leave the site.
- In another day or two you will receive an email telling you which Academy trainer you may contact should you have questions about functionality.

Please make sure to arrive at your scheduled time a few minutes early.
