Between January 1, 2021, and December 31, 2021, The Department of Children and Families has received a total of one hundred and thirty-four (134) written reports from the Department of Agriculture. Of the one hundred and thirty four (134) reports received, twenty were open cases, thirty six (36) had histories with DCF and eight (8) reports met the standard for an abuse/neglect investigation based on the initial information provided in the written report.
