Subject: 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Payment Status

As we continue to progress through this time, we at the Department are very aware of the financial impact that this pandemic is having on our provider partners. To that end, we petitioned the Office of Policy and Management for early release of 4th Quarter payments for all contracted, budget-based providers. Early yesterday, OPM approved our request and released our allotments. To that end, our Contracts staff have been working tirelessly for the last day to prepare your payments and we anticipate that the majority, if not all, of our state funds and most of our federal funds tied to your 4th Quarter payments will be released by end of week.

Payment of state funds will be made in full for 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter with no holdbacks (other than those already communicated to you based on reconciliation of prior year unexpended funding). Additionally, in light of our current situation, the Department will be lenient in its approach to review of year end financial reports and their compliance with established variance levels.
