

Possible Deliverables/Key Tasks (cont'd)

- ▶ Draft QRTP regulations, policies/procedures, QRTP flow sheet
- ▶ Outline various processes (e.g., how assessment information gets to court, targeted disposition planning around the 60 day benchmark)
- ▶ Develop documentation for processes (e.g., involvement of permanency team in placement)
- ► Survey regional, youth, family needs
- ► Creating trauma informed systems (NCTSN resources)
