I am pleased to submit the 2022 Annual Report Concerning Actual or Suspected Instance of Animal Neglect or Cruelty as required under C.G.S. section 17a-110c.

Between January 1, 2022, and December 31, 2022, The Department of Children and Families has received a total of one hundred and seven (107) written reports from the Department of Agriculture. Of the one hundred and seven (107) reports received, forty-five (45) had histories with DCF and ten (10) reports met the standard for an abuse/neglect investigation based on the initial information provided in the written report.

In addition, I'm attaching a de-identified summary of the reports received, by month, for your review.
