## WELCOME TO DCF LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

As the 2024 legislative session has ended and bills are being transmitted to Governor Lamont's office, we would like to update you on some bills that passed and may be of interest.

We will have another update once all bills have become official public acts and signed into law by Governor Lamont.

All bills that passed both chambers can be found <u>here</u>.

There is one bill that has been <u>discussed publicly to get vetoed</u> by Governor Lamont. <u>HB 5164 AN</u> <u>ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS</u>, which would allow certain striking employees to access unemployment benefits.

H.B. 5436 AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATOR CERTIFICATION, TEACHERS, PARAEDUCATORS AND MANDATED REPORTER REQUIREMENTS.

HB 5437 AN ACT CONCERNING EDUCATION MANDATE RELIEF, SCHOOL DISCIPLINE AND DISCONNECTED YOUTH.

HB 5508 AN ACT CONCERNING RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE JUVENILE JUSTICE POLICY AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

HB 5523 AN ACT CONCERNING ALLOCATIONS OF FEDERAL AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO GENERAL GOVERNMENT, HUMAN SERVICES, EDUCATION AND THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2025.

SB 1 AN ACT CONCERNING THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF CONNECTICUT RESIDENTS.

<u>SB 126 AN ACT CONCERNING IN-PERSON HOME VISITS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.</u>

SB 127 AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES RELATING TO BACKGROUND CHECKS, CERTAIN SUBSIDIES, URGENT CRISIS CENTERS, DEPARTMENTAL RECORDS AND SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS.
