	captured through the MDT Evaluations, and Universal Issues will be developed and presented to the Task Force.	
	Data- Need to look at the Data points that have been gathered through the MDT Evaluation committee. There is an opportunity to	
	have a larger conversation on Universal Issues identified and team-specific areas for improvement.	

Workflow — How will this work be completed? Is this a workgroup? We will assess the data first (what we currently have and what we need). Gather the data and ask people for some overall data points from their agencies or areas. Once we have the data, we might convene a workgroup or convene a consultant to assist in developing performance measures. Timeline for the Data — We will develop a survey monkey that will include some of these questions. What data points do we need? What data do you have in your area that might be helpful in these particular areas? Consultant to look at Health Equity Plans or Racial Equity and Bias Work. There was a suggestion to lobby the legislature to support funding for this project. Agencies can also share how they individually take on Racial Equity and Bias work in their specific areas.
