The Department of Children and Families (DCF) employs Health Advocates to improve health outcomes by helping DCF youth and families access healthcare services at the point of their need. Health Advocates assist with all agency legal statuses throughout the DCF system of care from the time a family is involved with DCF until their case is closed. Health Advocates are located in the regional offices and their duties are:

- 1. To resolve problems with health care access and insurance coverage for services.
- 2. To design systems that ensure better health outcomes.
- 3. To explain how to access services with Medicaid and private insurance.
- 4. To verify Medicaid eligibility and facilitate enrollment in Medicaid.
- 5. To provide information and training to DCF staff, foster parents, facility staff on Medicaid and DCF health care policies.
- 6. To make referrals to the foster care clinics for Multi-Disciplinary Exams (MDEs).
