Committee Deadlines:

The Select Committee on Special Education is the lone remaining committee to not yet have its deadline pass, which is this Wednesday April 30th.

Adjournment: The General Assembly Adjourns on June 4th at midnight.

Appropriations, Budget and Finance Related Information

The Governors budget and deficiency bills passed out of the Appropriations committee.

H.B. No. 6864 AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, 2027, AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR.

The Governor's budget was amended with <u>LCO No. 7303</u> and an additional amendment that would "<u>Increase Special Education Excess Cost in FY 26 and FY 27 by \$84 million</u>" was amended into the bill as well.

HB 6863 passed as is with no amendments.
