<u>Committee Deadlines:</u> All committee deadlines have now passed.

Some committees will still have meetings to address bills that have been referred to their committee from their chamber of origin.

The bills they will address have already passed out of at least one committee and/or it's committee of origin.

Adjournment: The General Assembly Adjourns on June 4th at midnight.
