WELCOME TO DCF's LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Welcome to the second edition of the DCF Legislative Update for the 2025 session of the General Assembly.

The legislative session is underway with most committees having met over the past week and more scheduled for the coming week.

There have been two new committees established with the general assembly: The <u>Government Oversight Committee</u> and the <u>Select Committee</u> on <u>Special Education</u>.

<u>Committee Deadlines:</u> The deadline for all committees on proposed bills to be introduced was 5pm today.

<u>Adjournment</u>: The General Assembly Adjourns on June 4th at midnight, which is later than in even numbered years due to the State Biennium budget adoption taking place in the odd numbered years.
