# WELCOME TO DCF's LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Welcome to the third edition of the DCF Legislative Update for the 2025 session of the General Assembly.

The legislative session is well underway with all committees having met over the past few weeks and many public hearings starting to get scheduled.

<u>Committee Deadlines:</u> The committee bill deadline (if no subject matter public hearing) for the Committee on Children is Tuesday February 4<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Adjournment</u>: The General Assembly Adjourns on June 4th at midnight, which is later than in even numbered years due to the State Biennium budget adoption taking place in the odd numbered years.
