Welcome to the ninth edition of the DCF Legislative Update for the 2025 session of the General Assembly.

<u>Committee Deadlines:</u> The Committee on Children's Joint Favorable deadline is Tuesday March 11th.

<u>Adjournment</u>: The General Assembly Adjourns on June 4th at midnight, which is later than in even numbered years due to the State Biennium budget adoption taking place in the odd numbered years.
