The Department of Children and Families (DCF) is pleased to submit the annual report required by Public Act 14-70, An Act Concerning Cross Reporting of Child Abuse and Animal Cruelty.

Between January 1, 2018, and December 31, 2018, The Department of Children and Families has received a total of sixty nine (69) written reports from the Department of Agriculture. Of the sixty nine (69) reports received, eighteen (18) had histories with DCF and four (4) reports met the standard for an abuse/neglect investigation based on the initial information provided in the written report.
