- the Differential Response System,
- expansion of and increased support for foster families, with special attention to relative family placements,

- increased use of evidence-based in-home and community programs and implementation of performance-based contracting for DCF provider agencies and
- improvement in case planning and meeting children's and families' needs

The Department of Children and Families is committed to achieving positive outcomes for children and their families involved with the child welfare system. The Strengthening Families Regional Implementation Team is a critical piece of this work. I look forward to partnering with you on this very important initiative.
