# **ACTION STEPS**

## **REGION 1**

Enhance membership of families & youth by:

- 1. Reach out to YAB
- 2. Reach out to FAM Systems Manager
- 3. Bridgeport Child Advocacy Coalition & PLTI

#### **REGION 2**

- 1. Link with YAB
- 2. Link with System & Care Community Collaborative and LIST to pull all collaboratives & initiatives together in considering a more unified approach
- 3. Use questions from retreat and above groups to keep RAC on track

#### **REGION 3**

- 1. Bringing YAB voice to RAC discussing Bill of Rights.
- 2. Survey to get information/engagement from range of community providers that may not yet be involved or have not stayed involved –maintain communication to work in coordinated way and maximize input
- 3. Get adolescent substance abuse, fathers' housing needs and JJ needs onto agenda

#### **REGION 4**

- 1. Connecting with YAB
- 2. Land-the-plane to decide on whether current new sub-committees and/or tie in to CQI teams (i.e. "Structure" decisions).
- 3. Develop training plan for RAC membership.

### **REGION 5**

- 1. Form Executive Planning ISS Committee tying in to RAC.
- 2. Looking at CRP funds as way to motivate/engage participant.
- 3. Bring dashboard into RAC meetings.
- 4. Determine other relevant data to bring in to RAC meetings.

#### **REGION 6**

- 1. Review the adolescent services info about transition age youth to ID gaps/needs.
- 2. Revive and expand scope of membership and outreach committee.
- 3. Use café style meeting to enhance participation of all.

#### **DCF LEADERSHIP TEAM**

- 1. Find way to better integrate/consolidate different advisory groups.
- 2. Maximize technology to promote dissemination of info.
- 3. Work with Casey to identify a training for RAC co-chairs.
- 4. Regular updates on grant activities to SACs and RACs.
