

# Substance Use Resource Guide

## FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

This document is intended to inform First Responders and other key partners on harm reduction, treatment and recovery services in Connecticut. There are various treatment options for individuals struggling with opioid use disorders. Paths to recovery include medications, inpatient treatment, 12-step programs, counseling and more. These resources aim to address substance use-related crises, prevent overdose deaths, and provide compassionate, evidence-based care.

#### Harm Reduction Services

Support individuals and communities in overdose prevention, syringe services and sexual health practices.



#### Substance Use Disorder Walk-In Assessment Centers

Dedicated centers where trained professionals provide compassionate and confidential evaluations for individuals seeking help with substance use issues, without the need for an appointment.



#### Methadone Treatment Programs

Methadone is a long-acting opioid antagonist that reduces opioid withdrawal symptoms and cravings, making it easier for individuals to engage in recovery activities.

### Naloxone and Opioid Overdose Rescue Kits
