

MULTISYSTEMIC THERAPY INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE (MST-IPV)

Program Overview

MST-IPV is an intensive (3-4 times weekly) evidence-based in-home treatment for families who are involved with the Department of Children and Families (DCF) due to the physical abuse and/or neglect of a child/children in the family and intimate partner violence (IPV) within the family. MST-IPV provides 24-hour emergency and crisis intervention services to children and their families by phone or pager.

Target Population

DCF-involved families where there has been recent substantiated abuse/neglect of the children (within last 180 days) due to intimate partner violence.

Length of Service

The service typically lasts 6-9 months.
