

## Care Coordination

### Program Overview

[Care coordination](#) services are provided to children and youth who have complex behavioral health needs and require an intensive coordination of multiple services to meet those needs.

### Target Population

Children and youth through age 18 (or still attending school):

- Who require coordination of multiple services/supports to meet the needs of the child/youth and their family
- Youth with serious mental/behavioral health challenges
- Who are at risk to be, or have already been, separated from their family and/or community (i.e. residential or hospital level care) for the primary purpose of receiving behavioral health or mental health related services

### Length of Service

The length of service for each child and family is generally up to 6 months. If the Child and Family Team identifies the need for additional time through the Care Planning process, an extension request may be submitted.
